IRON MOUNTAIN - Rudolph "Rudy" Seelund, 89, of Iron Mountain, died Sunday, Jan. 13, 2008, at the V.A. Medical Center in Milwaukee, Wis.

He was born on Sept. 7, 1918, in Metropolitan, son of the late John and Anna (Nygaard) Seelund. Rudy graduated from the Felch School. He served with the United States Army during World War II.
