KINGSFORD - Rugean M. Fraker, 92, formerly of Iron Mountain, died Sunday, Oct. 11, 2009, at the ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

She was born on Sept. 26, 1917, in Iron Mountain, the daughter of the late Herbert K. and Georgean F. (Powell) McDonnell. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1935, and then from Dundon's Business College.

On Dec. 26, 1940, she married Leon J. Fraker at the First Presbyterian Church on Brown Street. Except for brief stays in Pontiac, Mich. and Milwaukee, Rugean and "Teenie" lived their lives in Iron Mountain.

Rugean was employed as a secretary at the First National Bank for many years, retiring in 1982.

During her retirement, she and her husband rode thousands of miles as members of the Pleasure Riders Motorcycle Club. The couple also celebrated their 70th birthdays with a two-wheeled trip to California. Rugean was a member of the First Presbyterian Church where she sang in the choir for more than 50 years and also served on the session. She was a member of the Order of Eastern Star, the White Shrine, and the Daughters of the Nile.

Music was a very important part of Rugean's life. In addition to their church

choir, she sang with the Dickinson County Community Chorus and appeared in several Lion's Roars and community theatre productions. Beginning before World War II and continuing for many years afterward, she sang with her cousins Dorothy Underhill, Jean LaHaie and Tillie Miller as the popular vocal group "The Uren Sisters." Rugean was also a member of Matinee Musicale.

She is survived by her son, Dennis (Suzanne) Fraker of Iron Mountain; her son-in-law, John Wahlstrom of Kingsford; her grandchildren, Jennifer (Tim) Spreen and Kristin (Mark) Novara, both of Kingsford, Melissa (Brian) Jones of Fayetteville, N.C., Emily (Matt) Brown of Macon, Ill., and Ian Fraker of Marquette; her great-grandchildren, Keira, Paige and Carter Jones, Ella and Jack Spreen, Nicolas Novara and Camryn and Charlotte Brown; as well as many nieces and nephews. She is also survived by her brothers-in-law and sisters-in-law, Wayne and Beverly Fraker and Tony and Darlene Burgarino.

Rugean was preceded in death by her husband, Leon; her daughter, Karyn Wahlstrom; her brothers, Herbert and George McDonnell and an infant, sister Adele.

Visitation for Rugean Fraker will be Friday from 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. at First Presbyterian Church in Kingsford.

An Eastern Star memorial service will be held at 4 p.m. Friday followed by the funeral services. The Rev. Michael March will officiate.
