



Ruth Marie Marchaterre

May 29, 1927 - November 23, 2022

Ruth M. Marchaterre, 95, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Wednesday, November 23, 2022, at Evergreen Senior Living in Kingsford.

She was born on May 29, 1927, to Fred and Louise (Bushy) Marchaterre and grew up on a farm near Hermansville. After high school she attended nursing school in Marquette. She worked as nurse in Sault Ste. Marie and Green Bay, eventually spending many years at Pinecrest Nursing Home in Powers. After the family retired from farming in the mid-1970s, they moved into town. She and her twin sister Ruby nursed their parents during their last illnesses.

She retired from nursing in 1989. A few years later she and Ruby moved to Iron Mountain where they were parishioners at St. Mary Queen of Peace in Kingsford.

She is remembered for her gentle spirit. She loved crafts, the outdoors, animals, gardening, snowmobiling, and hunting. She also loved the rosary and watching EWTN.

She was preceded in death by her parents and by her brother John Marchaterre. She is survived by her twin sister Ruby who will miss her dearly and who helped care for her during her last days; and by her nieces, John's daughters: Mary (Rick) Vilim, Ann (Scott) Hamilton, and Madeleine (Joel)

Super.
