IRON MOUNTAIN - Ruth D. Saxon, 83, of Iron Mountain passed away on Tuesday, Dec. 8, 2009, at ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

She was born Feb. 3, 1926, daughter of the late Gust and Matilda (Ostrom) Gustafson. Ruth attended school in Felch through the 11th grade and graduated with the Kingsford High School class of 1944.

On July 12, 1947, she married Wayne Saxon at First Lutheran Church in Iron Mountain. He preceded her in death in 1974.

A lifelong resident of the area, Ruth worked in food service at the V.A. Hospital. She was a member of Our Saviour's Lutheran Church and was actively involved in many capacities including the choir, church Circle, quilting, and Sunday school.
