Sally Ann Kmit, 66, of Niagara passed away at home and went to be with the Lord on Fri. Sept. 21, 2012 with her family and friends by her side after a courageous battle with cancer. Sally was born in Iron Mountain on Feb. 24, 1946, the daughter of the late Cedric and Janet (Bannow) Gard.
