



## Samantha Smoot

November 25, 1973 - August 13, 2010

Samantha Marie Smoot, 36, of Kingsford, passed away on Friday, Aug. 13, 2010, at her home with her family by her side after a long courageous battle with brain cancer.

She was born on Nov. 25, 1973, in Iron Mountain, daughter of Robert Staple and the late Marcella Hoyum. She attended the Breitung Township Schools, graduating from Kingsford High School in 1992.

She married Will Smoot on Aug. 8, 1998, in Iron Mountain.

Sam currently worked as a librarian at the Dickinson County Library. Her love of reading and children made going to work a real joy for her. Her passion for animals previously led to employment at the Spring Lake Humane Society. Her amazing free spirit, kindness and determination will be missed by many.
