Sarah Lynn Hoffman, 33, of Iron Mountain, died unexpectedly Friday, Oct. 1, 2010, at Bell Memorial Hospital in Ishpeming.

She was born on July 5, 1977, in Iron Mountain, daughter of Richard Ledgend and Marjorie Turner Garrow. Sarah graduated from North Dickinson High School in 1995.

She married Michael Hoffman on June 17, 1997, in Iron Mountain. Sarah worked as a surgical technician at the Garrett Eye Center the past eight years. Sarah was a wonderful mother to her three beautiful children. Sarah was also a caring, giving person, always concerned for others. She was a member of the Sagola Presbyterian Church and a strong supporter of the U.P. Bear Houndsman Association. She enjoyed horseback riding and raising Westies and bear dogs.
