Scott A. Doolittle, 45, of Iron Mountain, died on Monday June 20, 2011 in Bellefontaine, OH. He was born on May 24, 1966 in Syracuse, New York, the son of Larry and Connie (Vecchio) Doolittle.

He spent his childhood in Syracuse and joined the U.S. Army. During his six year tour, he was stationed at Fort Hood, TX, Ft. Benning, GA, and in Germany.

Scott worked as a truck driver for different companies, and was currently driving for Four Seasons Distributing.
