WARREN - Sidney E. Cadieu, 98, passed away on Tuesday, May 23, 2006, in Warren, lower Michigan.

Sid was born in Cour De Lane, Idaho., and was an only child. He recent residence was with his daughter in Warren. His last two homes were in Iron Mountain, and Dunbar, Wis. Over the years he lived in many places out west. Sid was a graduate of Iron Mountain High School in 1925.

He was living in Kingsford, when he and Ella were married, they then moved to Phelps, Wis. He and his family moved out west in 1946, then they lived in Grand Junction, Estes Park and Roggen, Colo. He had lived in Roggen as a young child. They returned to Kingsford in 1948. In 1954, they built a home by Lilly Lake, Dunbar, Wis., on land that had been homesteaded by Sid's mother and her parents.

Sid had once belonged to the Masons and over the years he had been active with the Toastmasters organization. He was too old for World War II, so he went down to Janesville, Wis. to work as a guard at a plant that dealt in war equipment, as he wanted to do something.

He leaves his daughter Betty (John, deceased) Catalano, and three

grandchildren, Juniata (Tom) Michelin, Mark Catalano and Scott Catalano. He also has many relatives in Northern Sask, Canada.
