IRON MOUNTAIN - Signie M. Larsen, 94, of Quinnesec, died Tuesday, Jan. 14, 2003, at Hyland Nursing Home in Iron Mountain.

She had been a resident of this area for most of her life and was a 1927 graduate of Amasa High School.
