



Sister Marie Leeman

February 3, 1942 - August 30, 2012

Sister Elizabeth Marie of the Trinity, OCD, (Margaret Marie Leeman), 70, a member of the Carmelite Community, died August 30, 2012, at the Carmelite Monastery in Iron Mountain, located at U.S. 2-M-95.

Sister Elizabeth Marie was born on February 3, 1942, in Green Bay, Wis., the daughter of the late Monroe and Veronica Leeman.

Sister Elizabeth entered the Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity of Manitowoc, Wis. in 1958, making her First Profession of Vows on August 15, 1962. Sister transferred to the Carmelite Monastery of the Holy Cross on June 26, 1989, and pronounced her Profession of Perpetual Vows as an Extern Sister on October 15, 1993. Sister has resided at the Carmelite Monastery since that time.
