He worked around the kitchen whether it was making sandwiches or doing dishes. He didn't complain, but had that little smile always on his face.

In the latter years, he silently endured heart disease and emphysema. He and the other vets enjoyed their once-a-year dinner at the Elks Lodge No. 700 in honor of their war time service. He loved going out to eat.

Stanley called Haven House his family and is survived by Elaine, Bob, Christy, Stella, Muriel, Misty, Nilo, Steve, Matt, Conrad, Stan, Robert, John, Larry,

Donald, Frankie and David. He will be greatly missed.
