IRON MOUNTAIN - Sylvia Schinderle, 96, of Iron Mountain, died on Saturday, Nov. 21, 2009, at ManorCare Health Services in Kingsford.

She was born on June 13, 1913, in Iron Mountain, daughter of the late Theodore and Freda (Berglind) Norgren Nordquist. She worked at Crystal Lunch for many years in Iron Mountain.
