Theodora A. Beauchamp, 98, of Kingsford, died Thurs. Dec. 12, 2013 at Freeman Nursing and Rehabilitation Community. She was born on Sept. 4, 1915 in Iron Mountain, the daughter of the late Angelo and Theresa (Rainaldi) Caruso. She graduated from Iron Mountain High School in 1933.
