Theresa J. Hammill, 84, of Vulcan, died Thurs. Feb. 7, 2013 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. She was born on March 2, 1928 in Vulcan, the daughter of the late John and Caroline (Bond) Menapace.

A lifelong resident of Vulcan, Theresa graduated from Vulcan High School in 1946. She married Howard Hammill on Aug. 30, 1946 at St. Barbara Catholic Church in Vulcan. He preceded her in death in 1969.
