Thomas Anthony Pfister, 79, of Quinnesec passed away on Thursday, August 1, 2024, at the Oscar G. Johnson VA Medical Center.

Tom was born on June 7, 1945, in Jamaica, New York, the son of the late Anthony and Marian (Rouse) Pfister. He enlisted with the U.S. Navy on Oct. 5, 1965, and served until Oct. 4, 1967, while living in California. Tom moved to Michigan in 1980, to raise his family. After his return he took a position as a cook for the priests at the local rectory. Tom was an avid outdoorsman. He loved spending time at camp, fishing, hunting, and observing animals and nature. Tom also enjoyed playing his bass guitar in his younger years, watching the Packers, and collecting historical guns.
