Todd "Chips" Fredy, 53, of Munising, formerly of this area, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, April 20, 2012, in Panama City, Fla.

Todd was born on Sept. 28, 1958, in Iron Mountain, son of the late William and Joyce (Cambray) Fredy. He has been a lifelong resident of this area.

Recently he had been living in Munising and had traveled to Florida to do rescue work. After graduation from North Dickinson High School in 1977, Todd spent six years in the United States Marine Corps. He was a sniper instructor at Camp Lejeune, N.C. and served as a sniper during the evacuation of Granada, code named operation Urgent Fury in 1983.

Todd was an outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting, fishing and sitting by a campfire. He was also an avid Green Bay Packer fan.

He is survived by his sons, Chad (LeeAnn) Fredy of Escanaba and Jeffery Fredy of Junction City, Kan.; brothers, William "John" Fredy of Skandia, Harry (Sally) Fredy of Iron River and Richard (Connie) Fredy of Colorado; grandson, Rylie Beauchamp and granddaughter, Jillian Willette.
