Trent Lee Byerley, 41, of Iron Mountain passed away on Saturday, Oct. 29, 2022, at his home after suffering from PTSD.

Trent was born on April 16, 1981, in Beloit, WI, the son of Randy Byerley and Susan K. Woodard-Brown. After high school, he enlisted with the U.S. Army, serving from Oct. of 2000 - April 2011 as a member of Infantry 11B, Blue Spaders and Ramrods units. During his service he earned the Army Good Conduct Medal (3rd award), National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, Kosovo Campaign Medal, Iraq Campaign Medal with Campaign Star, Army Service Ribbon, Overseas Service Ribbon, NATO Medal, Infantryman Badge/driver and Mechanic Badge. He married Rachael Ann Byerley on Oct. 6th, 2020.
