Vernon E. Weinfurter, 78, of East Kingsford, died Sun. June 30, 2013 at Dickinson County Memorial Hospital. He was born on July 4, 1934 in Kingsford, the son of the late Edward and Viola (Beaulier) Weinfurter. He graduated from Kingsford High School in 1952 and served in the U.S. Navy on the U.S.S.
