Veronica J. Leeman, 94, passed away on Thursday, July 29, 2010, at her home in Channing.

She was born on April 21, 1916, in DePere, Wis., the daughter of the late Leonard and Lydia (DeCleene) Hendricks. She resided in Green Bay, Oneida and Marinette for many years before moving to Channing in 1984.

Veronica married Monroe Leeman in 1937, and they were married for more than 50 years. They raised their family of 15 children before Monroe preceded her in death in 1991. She was the loving matriarch of her large family and enjoyed this role with love and guidance.

First and last in her life was her love of Jesus Christ and she was always a witness to that. Veronica was a member of St. Rose Catholic Church in Channing.
