On Sunday, March 20, 2022, Vonna Raye Hawley, our beautiful wife, mother, grandmother and friend of Goodman, was guided to heaven by the angels.

She was born in Rapid City, SD on Sept. 30, 1934, to the late Charles W. and Dorothea (Adams) Fees. Vonna was a graduate of Alma Center High School, Class of '52. On Aug. 15, 1953, at St. Joan of Arc Catholic Church, Vonna married and devoted 68 years to her beloved husband, Don Hawley.

After lovingly raising seven children, she went to work for the Goodman-Armstrong Creek School District. In 1973, she was hired as a dishwasher, and 27 years later, retired as the food service director. She also was the Union President for the support staff during part of that time. Vonna dedicated her time to the community through her service as an EMT for the Goodman-Armstrong Creek Rescue Squad during its founding years. homemade computer birthday cards had the most heartfelt words.
