



Warden E. "Sonny" Lindstrom

Warden E. "Sonny" Lindstrom, 90, of Aurora, passed away on Wednesday, December 18, 2019 at Aspirus Iron River Hospital.

He was born February 9, 1929 in Aurora, WI, son of the late Elmer and Alice (Provencher) Lindstrom. He graduated from Coleman High School in 1947. Following graduation he enlisted in the U.S. Army and was a Korean War Veteran. Sonny married Margaret Olson in May of 1953 in Aurora.
