KINGSFORD - Warner R. Yaggie, 86, of 1820 Mary's Way, Kingsford, formerly of 802 E. Smith St., Iron Mountain, died Thursday, June 12, 2008, at ManorCare Health Care Services in Kingsford.

He was born July 5, 1921, in Butler, Wis., son of the late Edward and Mabel (Berry) Yaggie. Warner was a longtime resident of Iron Mountain.
