FELCH - Wesley J. Oman, 76, of Felch, died on Sunday, Nov. 16, 2008, at his home in Felch surrounded by family.

Wesley was born May 28, 1932, in Foster City, son of Edward and Ester (Ovist) Oman. At nearly five years old, Wes and two older brothers were orphaned. Wes and his brothers were taken in and raised by his maternal grandmother, Anna Louise.

Wes attended school in Felch through the ninth grade, when he left school and went to work. Wes enlisted in the Air Force and served as a tail gunner on B-29s in Korea.

During this time he continued to provide financial support for his beloved grandmother by sending home money each month. Upon his honorable discharge, he returned to Felch and went to work logging. He purchased a team of horses and became self-employed running a logging operation.

Through the years he ventured into several businesses including heavy equipment contractor, produce broker, trucking and land development. He constructed and ran a restaurant, gas station and small engine repair shop.

He was always successful as a businessman because he defined success as

getting what you need by hard work, honesty and fairness. He had little tolerance for anyone who did not share his ideals.

He was very interested and involved in our government. He felt strongly about our responsibility to our country and community. Wes was elected Felch Township supervisor, serving two terms. He attended Bay de Noc College in Escanaba obtaining certification as a tax assessor.

He served on the Felch Township Fire Department. He was a member of the Felch-Breen Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) serving as post commander for several years. He was an active member of the Knights of Columbus.

When he retired he worked repairing and restoring old equipment, gardening and drove school bus for the North Dickinson School. Wes loved the kids.

His family was very important to him. First and foremost was his wife of 54 years, Arlene (Zeeb). They were married on Nov.13, 1954, at St. Mary Catholic Church in Norway. Together Wes and Arlene had 10 children. All survive him. Wesley Jr. "Buddy" (Kim) Oman of Ralph, Randy (Betsy) Oman of Felch, Louise (Dwight) Lee of Iron Mountain, Steven (Peggy) Oman of Felch, Kristine (Tim) Bennett of Spooner, Wis., Darrell (Lynn) Oman of Felch, Gordon (Sandi) Oman of Felch, Mary Oman of Iron Mountain, Clayton Oman of Felch and John (Heidi) Oman of Felch. Wesley is also survived by 22 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, Wes was preceded in death by his brothers, unnamed Baby Oman, Clayton Oman, Gordon Oman, Marlyn Oman, and Gordon Edward Oman.

Visitation will be held on Thursday from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Foster City.

The Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 1 p.m. Thursday at the church.

A graveside service will be held followed by military services by the Felch-Breen V.F.W. Burial will be in the Felch Cemetery.
