Willard D. Bednarz, 75, of Kingsford passed away on Friday, November 29, 2019 at St. Vincent Hospital in Green Bay, Wisconsin.

Will was born Jan. 23, 1944, in Iron Mountain, MI, son of the late Warren and Marion (Larson) Bednarz. He was raised in Norway, MI, and Grafton, WI. Will was drafted into the US Army during the Vietnam War, served two years and was stationed in Germany. When he arrived home, he married Mary Dornfeldt, and they were married for 50 years. He worked at Lodal in Kingsford for 17 years, Lake Shore for many years, and served as a TSA officer at Ford Airport for 8 years. He enjoyed fishing, the outdoors, reading nonfiction westerns, and playing Texas Hold'em poker for charity events at the KC Hall. He loved and cared for many animals and is survived by his dog, Shadow. He was a devoted Christian and a member of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church.

Will is survived by his wife, Mary Bednarz; his brother, Gary Bednarz; his son, Matthew (Sara) Bednarz; his daughter, Ann (Daniel) Pedo; his grandchildren, Chris, Eric, Cecil, Cody and Alice; 10 great-grandchildren; and his aunts and uncles.

Along with his parents and grandparents, Will was preceded in death by aunts and uncles.
