FELCH ? Willard T. Hord, 80, of Felch died Wednesday, Oct. 1, 2003, at his home.

He was born March 18, 1923, in Norway, son of the late Fred and Signe (Lindquist) Hord. He has been a life long resident of this area. Willard was a veteran of World War II and served four and a half years with the United States Coast Guard on the USS Durant. He married Genevieve McEwing on Oct. 19, 1946 in Iron Mountain. Willard worked as a heavy equipment mechanic at Hanna Mining Company for 21 years. He was a member of the United Commercial Travelers, Uren-Cooper-Johnson American Legion Post 50, The Veterans of Foreign Wars and a longtime member of Oak Crest Golf Club.
