



William "Bill" Cavaiani

William F. "Bill" Cavaiani, 93, of Iron Mountain, passed away on Friday, May 14, 2010, at St. Paul Elder Services in Kaukauna, Wis.

Bill was born on Oct. 30, 1916, in Iron Mountain, son of the late Alfred and Margaret (Giachino) Cavaiani. He was salutatorian of the graduating class of 1934 at Iron Mountain High School and went on to attend Dundon Business College.

Bill was a World War II veteran serving as a first sergeant in the Army Air Corp from 1942-1945. He married Ardis Backlund on Sept. 6, 1941, and she preceded him in death in 1978. On February 4, 1983, Bill married Catherine "Kaye" Orzechowski, who preceded him in death in 2007.

He was employed at Wittock Supply Co. for more than 20 years as office manager. Bill and his brother, Albert "Gabber," owned and operated Cavi's Supper Club in Aurora, Wis. for more than 25 years.

He was a longtime member of the Elks Club, the Lions Club and St. Mary and St. Joseph Church. Bill enjoyed music and was an accomplished musician who played the violin, guitar and cornet. Along with his brother and occasionally his father, Bill was a key part of a number of dance bands that played for years throughout the Midwest.

He was an avid fast pitch softball player until his mid 40s when he took up golfing. In 1988, Bill shot a hole-in-one on #17 at Oak Crest Golf Course where he was a member for many years. With his quick wit and warm smile, Bill touched countless friends, relatives, and strangers with a kind word or thoughtful deed. He enjoyed nothing more than spending time with family and friends and will be sadly missed.

Bill is survived by three sons, William L.
