William Gordon "Bill" Ellis, 63, son, brother, husband, father, grandfather, and friend, died on Thursday, October 20, 2016 at his home in Quinnesec. He was born on Feb. 25, 1953 in Iron Mountain.

Bill graduated from Kingsford High School. He was a millwright for many places, most recently for Cliffs Natural Resources, where he retired from in 2014.

Bill was the most generous man with his time and love. He was always the guy that helped others without hesitation.
