William "Bill" Harvey, 86, of Kingsford passed away Saturday, November 16, 2024, at his camp in Waucedah.

Bill was born on December 29, 1937, in Norway, MI, son of the late Roy and Bernice (Roland) Harvey. He graduated from Vulcan High School in 1956 and was a lifelong resident of the area.
