William "Bill" Lindstrom , 74, of Spread Eagle passed away on Sunday, January 10, 2016 at his home after a 2 1/2 year battle with cancer. He was born on October 2, 1941 in Iron Mountain, son of the late Roy and Dorothy (Safstrom) Lindstrom. Bill attended school in Iron Mountain, graduating from Iron Mountain High School in 1959. He married Bonita "Bonnie" Montowski in Des Plaines, Illinois on March 8, 1974, and they have spent nearly 42 wonderful years together. Bill began his working career with General Controls in Iron Mountain. He moved with General Controls to Illinois and continued his career as a supervisor for City Products. Bill is survived by his loving wife, Bonnie ; his son, David (Karen) Lindstrom of Austin, Texas; his daughters, Sherrie and Cindy; his granddaughters, Kyla and Kate Lindstrom and his Aunt Lucille Carlson of Norway; he is further survived by several nieces, nephews and cousins, including a special nephew, James Taylor and a special friend, Swede Carlson.

He was preceded in death by a brother, Jim Lindstrom and a sister, Barbara Liddle.
